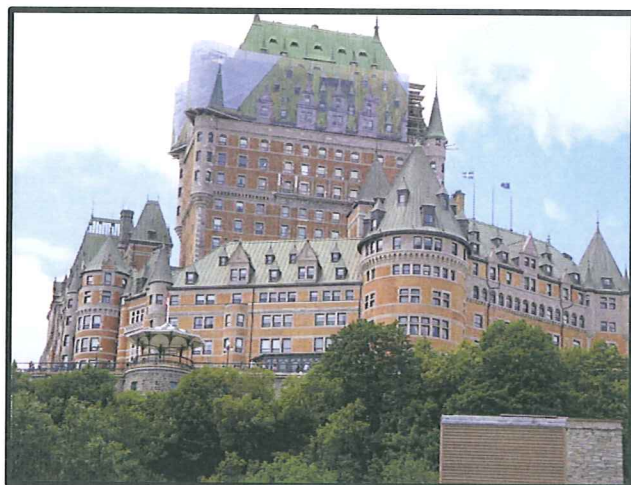

Faculty Led Program: Study in CANADA

School of Agriculture & Environmental Sciences

PROGRAM OVERVIEW



Location: Montreal, Canada

Duration: 3 weeks

Credit: Up to 6 credit hours

Description:

Participants will study French at the University of Quebec at Montreal, with an option to take an International Agriculture course.

Estimated Program Fee -\$3,150* (Includes \$150 application charge, French course, on-campus housing, airfare, classroom resources, cultural excursions and overseas health insurance).

In-country Costs: \$500 (to be taken with you to cover personal expenses).

**Please note estimated program fee is based on airfare not to exceed \$700. Fee is subject to change if airline tickets cost more. The above costs do not include A&T Tuition & Fees for the International Ag course. Enrollment in course(s) is required for participation in program.*

HOW TO APPLY

- Create an account on OIP's website in order to apply to a program;
- Have a GPA of **2.5** at the time of application & at departure unless waived by the faculty leader;
- Be at least a sophomore in good standing;
- Attend a General Information Session; and
- Have the approval of the Office of International Programs.

Final Application Deadline:
March 17th (no refunds after airline tickets have been purchased).

PAYMENTS

All payments are to be made to the Cashier's Office in the Dowdy Building. Download a transmittal form within the on-line application portal for your program and bring your payment and transmittal form to the Cashier's Office. Checks and money orders are made payable to "NC A&T State University". Please bring receipt to the Office of International Programs.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you decide to cancel your study abroad plans, you will receive a full refund if you notify OIP, in writing, by March 31. If you cancel your plans after this date you will not receive a refund.
