If Options 1, 2 and 3 do not cover all of your study abroad expenses, you may want to ask your parent/legal guardian to apply for a Parent Plus Loan. If they are denied, you will be able to increase your student loan amounts.

1: Financial Aid Package

2: Scholarships

SCHOLARSHIP: Pell-Grant recipients can receive up to \$5,000 to cover study abroad fees.

FREEMAN ASIA SCHOLARSHIP: This scholarship is for students studying in East and Southeast Asia. Students can receive \$3,000 for the summer; \$5,000 for the semester; and \$7,000 for the academic year.

OIP TRAVEL GRANT: The
Office of International
Programs offers a travel
grant that helps cover study
abroad expenses.
