Protocol for Study Abroad Programs

Study Abroad Programs are credit bearing courses taken overseas, for which the student will receive a transcript from the overseas university. If the overseas course is taught by an A&T faculty member, the student will enroll at A&T and receive a grade from the accompanying faculty member. - ➤ Participating students must follow these procedures:
 - 1. Attend a General Information Session (click here for the schedule)
 - 2. Meet with the study abroad adviser at OIP
 - 3. Submit your application to OIP
 - 4. Attend mandatory <u>Pre-departure Orientation</u>
 - Financial aid may be applied to study abroad programs approved by OIP.

<u>Faculty</u> organizing Study Abroad Programs must submit the <u>Experience Abroad Proposal</u> <u>Form</u> to the Office of International Programs no later than *July 1* in the year preceding the proposed study abroad in order to allow enough time to prepare for the best program and advertising. The Office of International Programs will assist you with planning, marketing and managing your study abroad program.
