### **Protocol for Study Abroad Programs**

*Study Abroad Programs* are credit bearing courses taken overseas, for which the student will receive a transcript from the overseas university. If the overseas course is taught by an A&T faculty member, the student will enroll at A&T and receive a grade from the accompanying faculty member.   3. Submit your application to OIP
