Visa

Students are required to obtain one of D-3(Study Abroad), C-3 (Temporary Visit) or D-4 VISA(General Training). Certificate of Admission will send to home university and student must submit signed Certificate of Admission to local Korean Embassy or Consulate to obtain visa.(Except Chinese Citizens) For more detailed informations, please contact program coordinators listed in the contact information section.

- Number of people in a room: 2 persons
- Items of furnished furniture per person: bed, desk, chair, locker, closet

- Personal bedding items(pillow, quilt, bedsheet, etc.) and personal wash items are not provided. Students are advised to buy personal items either before departure from their country or in Korea after arrival.

Medical Insurance

All the international students must be covered by health/accident insurance to attend Kangnam University. They must purchase one of the following 2 insurance types on arrival in Korea through Kangnam University:

- National Health Insurance Corporation: KRW 29,900/month
- Private Health Insurance Corporation: KRW 150,000/year (prepayment)

In case of a medical emergency, students may go to the hospital for service. The student will have to pay the full fee up front, and then apply for some form of reimbursement from their insurance company. Medical costs in Korea are cheaper than those in the U.S., but please note that depending on student's condition, their bills can come out to large amounts.

From the airport to Kangnam University

- Kangnam University offers the airport pick-up service on designed dates.
- The public transportations available at the Incheon International Airport are the airport limousine bus and taxi.



- Airport Limousine: Purchase a bus ticket bound for YONGIN in front of the 7A platform on the 1st floor of the Incheon International Airport. Bus fare is around KRW 12,000 won. Get down at "Kugal Kangnam Village" bus stop.
- Taxi: Get a taxi at the taxi stand situated between the platforms 5C~8C on the 1st floor of the Incheon International Airport. Destination is Kangnam University. Fare is around KRW 70,000~100,000 won.
